Boys & Girl's Club (K-6th) – Full day program for 86 children: Bible lesson, singing, crafts, games and class presentation. Donated items provided.

Boys & Girl's Club (7^{th-}12th) – Full day program for 52 teens: Bible lesson, Dress for Success, Financial Workshop, and Social Media Tips. Facilitated Giant Jenga competition and hosted an Ice Cream Social. Donated items provided.

Cleveland House Assisted Living - Donations provided for residents.

Cleveland County Rescue Mission (Men's Shelter) – Cleaned, sorted, and reorganized pantry and condiment/spice closet. Sorted, folded, organized, and hung clothing. Deep-cleaned kitchen. Led worship service for 12 men. Prayed individually with residents. Donated items provided.

Construction – Prayer walked community, built wheelchair ramp and prayed with residents.

Heart 2 Heart (Women & Children's Shelter) – Full day program for eight women and three children. Led four sessions: housekeeping, goal-setting, finances/budgeting, professional dress & etiquette. Donated items provided.
