



## **2013 Mission Site Data Report**

Philadelphia, PA

June 11 – 16, 2013

This mission trip was one of the most challenging and rewarding events for our SOM mission team. Our focus was “Put God First” which was expressed in our daily devotionals with our theme, “Created to Do His Work” from Ephesians 2:10 which states, “*For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.*”
